

Adult Dogs: The amount of food required each day will vary by breed, activity level, temperament, and climate, and should be adjusted accordingly using the chart below as a guide. In most cases, once-a-day feeding is sufficient. If your dog prefers twice-a-day feeding, feed 1/2 of the daily

amount in the morning and the other 1/2 in the afternoon. If preferred, one part warm water can be added to three parts Star Pro® immediately before serving.
