

FEEDING SUGGESTIONS

Adult Dogs: The amount of food required each day will vary by breed, activity level, temperament, and climate, and should be adjusted accordingly using the chart below as a guide. In most cases, once-a-day feeding is sufficient. If your dog prefers twice-a-day

INGREDIENTS
